All parents and community are encouraged to participate in the School Site Council (SSC). The SSC develops and monitors the implementation of the Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA), proposes expenditures and evaluates the results.



The School Site Council is a group of teachers, parents, and classified employees that works with the Principal (s) and other County Office administration to develop, review, and evaluate school improvement programs and school budgets. Generally, the SCC either make decisions or advise the Principal(s) on the school budget, like the Title I funds and the academic or school improvement plan. In addition to academic planning, many site councils are also responsible for making decisions about parent engagement, and safety.
